FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Obey and Live: Responding to God's
Gracious Invitation

Key Text

ISAIAH 1:19,20

Some have wondered whether our theme sounds like a harsh ultimatum: obey or perish. A closer look at Scripture shows otherwise. God delights not in judgment but in salvation: **"I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live"** ([Ezekiel 33:11](#)). He is always seeking, always calling sinners home.

Isaiah's words, **"If you are willing and obedient, you shall eat the good of the land: but if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured with the sword"** ([Isaiah 1:19-20](#)), are not a threat from an angry God but the appeal of a loving Father pleading for His children to choose life. They follow directly after one of Scripture's most beautiful invitations: **"Come now, and let us reason together"** ([Isaiah 1:18](#)). God offers cleansing before consequences — grace precedes obedience.

This pattern runs throughout the Bible: Isaiah's call to seek the Lord and be abundantly pardoned ([Isaiah 55:6-7](#)), the apostles' call to repent because God desires all to be saved through Christ ([Acts 17:30](#)), and Paul's declaration that "the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men" ([Titus 2:11](#)) — a grace that not only forgives but teaches us to live soberly, righteously, and godly ([Titus 2:11-14](#)).

Obedience, then, is not the opposite of grace — it is grace received, the fruit of a transformed heart. The gospel does not say, **"Obey so that God may love you."** It says, **"Because God has loved you in Christ, surrender to Him and walk in His ways."** Hebrews echoes the same appeal: do not harden your heart ([Hebrews 3:15](#)), do not fall short of grace ([Hebrews 12:15](#)), but lay aside every weight and look unto Jesus, the Author and Finisher of our faith ([Hebrews 12:1-2](#)). God does not force obedience; He invites it.

The choice is indeed ours, but the invitation is God's.



As we gather for Camp Meeting 2026, may we hear not merely a command to obey, but the voice of a loving Savior calling us to life — and respond with willing surrender, joyful obedience, and steadfast faith. For the message of Isaiah is not just "Obey and Live." It is God's loving invitation: "Choose life. Choose Christ. Choose the grace that empowers obedience and leads to eternal life."

May the Lord richly bless us as we prepare for this sacred gathering.
